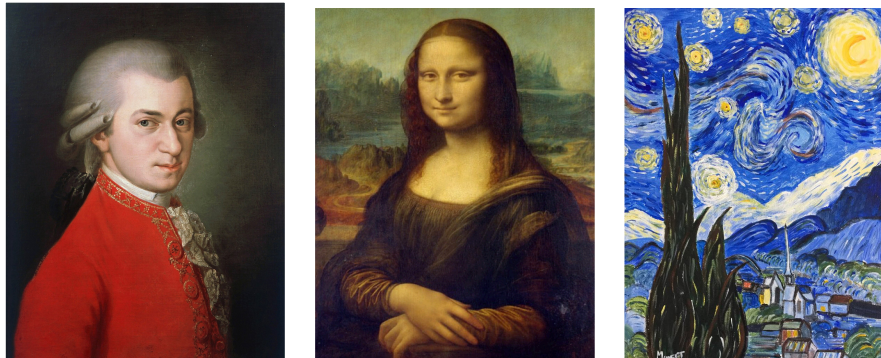


CREATING WITH ART HISTORY ARTISTS AND COMPOSERS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Class Description

Students will study famous artists and musical composers from the Medieval, Renaissance, Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and the 20th Century/Postmodern eras. There will be a variety of art projects to go along with each history lesson. We will be creating an art project relating to the artist of the day and listening to the music of the composer of that era and country. This course qualifies as a History credit as well as an art credit.

Cost
